

## **STADIUM RULES**

### General Conduct and Rules for all events and activities

#### **General Conduct:**

- No fighting, No Inappropriate Language
- No abuse of officials, coaches, or athletes.
- No unsportsmanlike conduct
- No rollerblades, roller skates within stadium, no bicycles only in designated areas.
- No dogs or pets allowed.

#### **General Rules:**

- Coach/or organization adult representative must be present at all times when the stadium is being used by authorized organization.
- No gum or sunflower seeds are allowed.
- No Gatorade, sport drinks, soft drinks, or any drinks other than water is allowed.
- No tables, chairs, benches, pop-up tents or anything with straight legs that can penetrate the field. All items that will go on the track or turf that are not provided by MUHSD and marked "**For Stadium Use**" must be approved by the site administration before being used (this includes game or sound equipment).
- No vehicles are allowed on the track or turf that are not provided by MUHSD and marked "**For Stadium Use**". **All drivers must review the "Track and Turf Care Rules" with the site administration before facility use is approved.**
- Absolutely nothing can be staked into the track or turf.
- No paint or other items that could stain the track or turf are allowed.
- Organizations are responsible to provide their own water jugs and water bottles for events. MUHSD Host will provide ice and water.
- All gates between the field/track and stands must remain closed and access to the field and track must be by "**Field Pass**" only during the event (only competing athletes, coaches, and cheerleaders do not need field passes).

#### **SHOES:**

- **On Turf: No baseball, track, golf, or shoes with heels, Only molded cleats or other athletic shoes.**
- **On the Track: No baseball, football, golf, or shoes with heels.**

#### **District Football games:**

- Field passes for visiting teams will be provided by the MUHSD Administrator on duty.
- The provided carpet **MUST** be used when crossing the track onto the football field.

#### **District Soccer and Other events:**

- For game day only, coaches, referees, and school administrators are allowed on the field.
- Night Games: Field passed will be provided by the MUHSD administrator on duty
